These are the measurements that work best:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Width for <u>ribbing</u> should be 2 1/2 inches; • Length for <u>neck size</u> for gowns and onesies should be 11"; • Length for <u>neck size</u> for sleepers should be 10"; • Length for <u>cuffs</u> for short sleeve should be 6" in length; • Length for <u>cuffs</u> for long sleeve should be 5" in length. <p>Thanks, Val, for realizing this information needs to be shared!</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>THANK YOU NOTE</u></p> <p>In part because of a massive sewing project done by Marian Graney, we were able to donate many quilts to Milwaukee Children's Hospital, along with some afghans in colors we don't use for the babies.
